

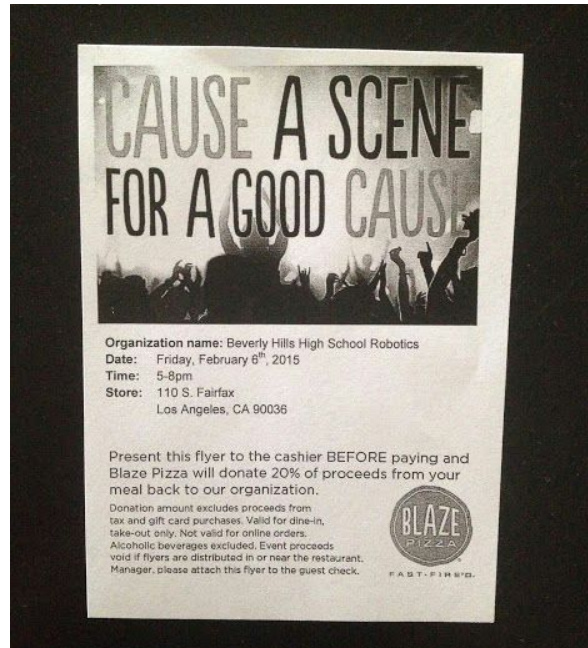
February
