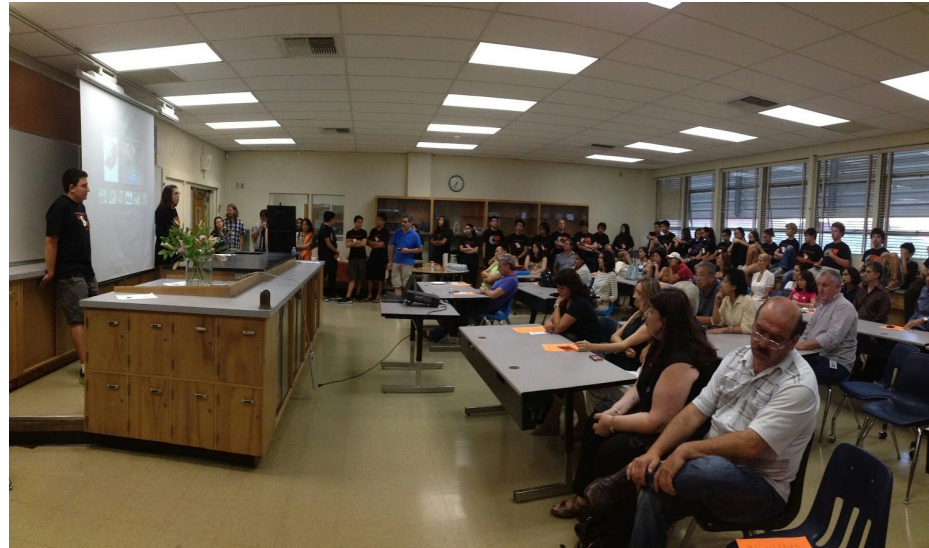


September
